SAFETY INFORMATION

Fire Danger

Smoking is prohibited on lifts and is only allowed in designated smoking areas. Report fires immediately via cell or on-mountain emergency phones.

Sun Protection

We recommend sunscreen with a sun protection factor of 15 or higher as well as eye protection.

Lightning and Thunderstorms

Afternoon thunderstorms are common in the mountains. Take proper precautions when you see or hear a storm developing: Seek shelter, keep off ridgelines, and stay clear of chairlift houses, lift towers, power lines, open spaces, lone trees and signposts. Three horn blasts at the top of the Gondola signify that an electrical storm is coming, and you should return to the Cliff House (Gondola summit building) if you can do so safely. Lifts may close on occasion, causing delays.

Adequate Clothing & Footwear

Be aware, mountain weather changes quickly and there is usually at least a 10 degree temperature difference from the bottom to the top of the lifts. Surface conditions vary. Closed-toe shoes appropriate for hiking are recommended. Bring a raincoat and consider a sweater or fleece.

Aerial Drones

Due to safety and privacy concerns for guests, employees and property, the operation or use of remotely controlled aerial systems, or drones, is prohibited above or within Stowe Mountain Resort.

Pets

We welcome sociable, furry friends outside at Stowe Mountain Resort as long as they are on a leash and under the control of a handler at all times. Dogs are not permitted in any of our buildings, with the exception of The Lodge at Spruce Peak (as a registered guest). Service dogs are welcome throughout the resort. Do not leave your dog unattended in your vehicle.

Lift Safety

You cannot board a lift unless you have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to negotiate or to use such lift safely or until you have asked for and received information sufficient to enable you to use the lift safely. You may not use a lift when under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Weather and Terrain

YOU ASSUME THE RISK of unpredictable weather, as well as rugged, uneven, irregular and slippery conditions.

Multi-Use

Be aware that trails and roads on Stowe Mountain Resort are used for many purposes during the summer. Hikers, motorized vehicles, construction equipment and others may be encountered at any time. Mountain biking is not permitted at Stowe Mountain Resort.

Construction Warning

You may encounter construction equipment, maintenance vehicles or other heavy machinery at any time. Always be cautious and obey posted signs and warnings.

Fragile Alpine Zone The summit of Mount Mansfield reaches 4,395 feet and is one of the few places in Vermont that is home to a unique alpine tundra zone. Follow these steps to protect the rare, fragile, and endangered vegetation: Walk only on rocks. No camping or woodfires. Please leash dogs.

Wildlife

Do not litter or feed wildlife. Hikers rarely encounter bears but, if you do, please remain calm and back away slowly. Stowe Mountain Resort asks that everyone is cautious and respectful of wildlife.
